Single membership £ 25.00 p.a.

Joint membership £ 40.00 p.a. (any two persons at the same address).

Family membership Adult rate + £5.00 p.a. per child.

Life membership £400.00 per person or £750.00 for joint membership.

Corporate membership £200.00 p.a. for eight membership cards.

Our preferred method of payment is by Direct Debit, as this helps us keep administration costs and bank charges to a minimum. Payment by cheque is of course still acceptable. Subscriptions are due on 1st January in each year, and where paid by Direct Debit will be claimed in the first business week following the 1st January. As Direct Debits are generally only processed in January, where a subscription is taken out during the year, please complete the Direct Debit form and enclose a cheque for any amount due for the current year with your application.

To protect our members we have given an indemnity to our Bankers, and you therefore have the following Guarantee:

THE DIRECT DEBIT GUARANTEE

This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits. If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit, The National Trust of Guernsey will notify you 30 days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request The National Trust of Guernsey to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.

If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by The National Trust of Guernsey or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.

- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when The National Trust of Guernsey asks you to.

You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting to your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please notify us.
